INNOVATORS & PIONEERS

Women of Inspiration has been Girls Inc. of Northern Alberta's signature mission-driven award program since 2012.

In 2019, Girls Inc. of Northern Alberta entered a multi-year partnership with Bouchier to launch a new series with the overarching theme, "You can't be what you can't see."

As we reached our 5-year milestone, we initiated another phase entitled 'Waves of Change: Charting the Path to Inspiration'.

Each year will highlight different industries, professions, and local talents that the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo (RMWB) has to offer by honouring local women in the Wood Buffalo region who break gender stereotypes, drive change, and advocate for women's and girls' rights and opportunities.

The 2025-2026 theme is 'Innovators & Pioneers'. This year, the series will celebrate local women who have made significant contributions in STEM fields, entrepreneurship, and creative industries.

Five awards will be presented in March 2026. These include:

- **Brilliance in STEM** Celebrating a woman who embraces curiosity, intellect, and transformative innovation.
- Innovator in Enterprise Celebrating a fearless woman turning vision into venture.
- Creative Luminary Celebrating a woman who illuminates new paths through the power of imagination and expression.
- Renaissance Pioneer Celebrating a woman at the intersection of science, business, and imagination.
- **Rising Star** Celebrating a woman who is a rising force in the fields of STEM, Entrepreneurship or Creative Arts.

Girls Inc. of Northern Alberta and Bouchier encourage nominations throughout the RMWB to highlight women who are driving Bouchier's community investment strategic priority around women's and girls' empowerment while inspiring all girls to be strong, smart, and bold—Girls Inc.'s mission.





NOMINATION CRITERIA

The nominee has positively impacted the community in one or more of the following:

- Breaking new grounds or old barriers for women and girls in RMWB to address intersecting factors and challenges around gender (in)equality and gender (in)justice
- Showing vision, creativity, and initiatives for a world in which all girls value their whole selves, discover their inherent strengths, and achieve their goals.
- Demonstrating wholistic leadership in the areas of Girls Inc. programmatic priorities: STRONG (Healthy Living), SMART (Knowledge Enrichment) and BOLD (Life Skills)
- Guiding, supporting, and encouraging the wellbeing of women, girls and 2SLGBTQQIA+ individuals, whose efforts may have been hidden or gone unnoticed without this Series
- Bringing transformative impact within and beyond the RMWB for greater diversity, equity, and inclusion

NOMINATION DETAILS

Eligible nominees MUST:

- Be living in the RMWB at the time of nomination
- Be at least 18 years of age at the time of nomination
- Consent to the nomination and publication of their name, photo and information
- Be committed to attending the Women of Inspiration Celebration presented by Bouchier in support of Girls Inc. of Northern Alberta on March 7, 2026
- Provide at least one (1) letter of reference/essay describing the nomination details and demonstrating how the nominee fits the nomination criteria.
- Nomination videos can also be accepted.

CATEGORY DETAILS

<u>Brilliance in STEM:</u> Honouring a woman whose exceptional brilliance in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics inspires others and sparks new ideas, approaches, and possibilities for the future.

<u>Innovator in Enterprise:</u> For a woman founder or business leader who's launched or scaled an impactful venture, disrupting norms and creating space for others.

<u>Creative Luminary:</u> Honouring a woman whose creative brilliance transcends boundaries—whether through art, design, storytelling, or innovation in the cultural space.

<u>Renaissance Pioneer:</u> Honouring a visionary woman whose work spans disciplines, bridging technology, enterprise, and creative expression.

<u>Rising Star:</u> Spotlighting an up-and-coming woman in any of the three sectors who shows exceptional talent, leadership, and potential to pioneer change.
